

# 2008 ~ 2009 Taiwan Scholarship

**Sponsors:** Ministry of Education (MOE) and National Science Council (NSC),  
Republic of China (Taiwan)

## **Scholarship Types:**

Undergraduate or postgraduate programs. Pre-degree Mandarin Language Enrichment Programs (LEP) is to be included per recipients' choice for improving language abilities.(Note: NSC scholarship offers postgraduate program only)

**Award Quotas:** Two ( 2 ) MOE scholarships

Two ( 2 ) NSC scholarships

**Benefits:** A monthly stipend of NT \$ 25,000 (approximately US\$769) for undergraduate or LEP study, and NT \$ 30,000 (approximately US\$923) for postgraduate programs (Scholarship recipients are responsible for all housing, tuition fees, health insurance and travel costs).

**Eligibility:** US citizen who does not possess the Republic of China (Taiwan) nationality and does not have the status of an overseas Chinese student as well as other criteria (see [details](#)).

## **Duration:**

- a. Undergraduate program: maximum 4 years.
- b. Master's program: maximum 2 years.
- c. Doctoral program: maximum 3 years.
- d. LEP program: maximum 1 year.

For any combination of these study programs, the length of total award for each recipient has a maximum of five years.

## **Application Requirement:**

Applicants need to submit the following documents:

- (1) Taiwan Scholarship Application Form with Study Plan□
- (2) Proof of highest educational qualifications and academic performance  
must have a GPA of at least 3.0 on a 4-point scale□
- (3) Proof of application to enroll at local university/college□
- (4) Must have sufficient Chinese language proficiency in terms of speaking and listening to be able to satisfy survival needs and maintain a very limited conversation on familiar topics; sufficient reading comprehension to read very simple written material in a form equivalent to usual printing and typescript.

**Deadline of Application:** March 31, 2008
